The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to remove the anomaly of petitioner and re-fix the pension on the basis of the last pay drawn, as amount of ₹ 54,410/- instead of ₹ 48,570/- w.e.f. the date of retirement and to further draw the arrears from December 2017 along with all consequential benefits and interest @ 12% p.a. as well as to decide the legal notice dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P-8).

Record perused.

On perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 31.03.2021 (Annexure P8) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
