Mr. S.S. Pannu, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

The grievance of the petitioner is that he is residing in Village Gumthala Rao, District Yamuna Nagar and there is illegal mining & overloading happening within a radius of 1 - 1½ Kilometers from his house due to which there is enormous amount of air pollution violating his fundamental rights. He also alleged that the roads have been damaged by the mining agencies operating in that area.

In this regard, the petitioner has lodged a complaint on 18.06.2019 with the Office of the Chief Minister, State of Haryana bearing No. CMOFF/N/2019/062757.

A final report has been issued by the Assistant Secretary, Office of the Regional Transport Authority, Yamuna Nagar mentioning that

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checking of overloading and illegal operation of vehicles is being done from time to time by a checking team, and that many other officers of the District have also been authorized by the Government to check overloading and illegal operation of vehicles.

The above report, however, does not give any finding as regards the allegations leveled by the petitioner as to whether or not there has been overloading, accumulation of dust around his house causing air pollution and as to whether or not the road has been damaged as alleged by the petitioner.

In this view of the matter, copy of the complaint dt. 18.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) be forwarded by the office of the respondent No.2 to respondent No. 3, who shall personally look into the complaint of the petitioner, cause an enquiry to be done and then communicate his decision to the petitioner within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
