Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 for taking action against private respondents for forging the documents. Further prayer has been made to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that after the death of petitioner's husband on 08.01.2020, the private respondents, who are his brothers etc. are making attempt to forcibly take possession of the land left behind by her husband. He submits that in this regard, representation dated 11.11.2021 (Annexure P-6) has already been given to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa, but till date no action has been taken upon the same. He prays that the directions be issued to the official respondent No.2 to decide the representation expeditiously by passing a speaking order.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that no suit for injunction has been filed by the petitioner and no other litigation between the parties is pending.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the above background, this Court is not inclined to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C as the petitioner can avail an alternative remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed.
