1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 16.12.2020 in CWP-14700-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-15773-2020 was disposed of vide order dated 16.12.2020 while directing the Punjab Public Service Commission to take a final decision on the claim of the petitioner within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned State counsel has produced copy of order dated 24.03.2022 that due to initiation of new recruitment for 320 posts of inspectors, no candidate had been given any appointment letter under the previous recruitment process. The aforementioned order is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof states that in view of order dated 24.03.2022 he does not press the instant petition and prays for grant of liberty to the

petitioners to challenge order dated 24.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

5. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
