Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for issuance of directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair, impartial and expeditious investigation and take action on the complaint given by the petitioner as conditional warrant issued for arrest of respondent No.5 by the Court of JMIC, Amritsar in case No.798 dated 11.01.2018 under Section 128 of Cr.P.C. at Police Station Veraka, Amritsar has not been executed.

Upon instructions from ASI Harpal Singh, State counsel submits that respondent No.5 has been arrested and produced before the learned Magistrate and has been ordered to undergo imprisonment for a period of 30 days.

Faced with this development, counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed and the petition has become infructuous.
