Prayer is for grant for anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case having FIR No.0341 dated 23.11.2021 registered under Sections 406/420 IPC Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal.

The present case was registered on the complaint of Jatinder Kumar wherein he alleged that he purchased car i20 having No.HR-26-DN-7751 after taking loan from ICICI Bank. In April 2021 petitioner and co-accused Ankur Bhadana approached him and asked him to give his car to them on the assurance that they would pay the installments of car loan. Then the petitioner handed over the said car for the purpose of plying to them subject to payment of installments of car loan by them. However, they did not deposit the

installments of car loan and also did not return the car and accordingly, FIR was registered.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in the light of the previous order of interim bail.

The State counsel on instructions from SI Durga Parshad has not disputed the aforesaid assertion made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the car belonging to the complainant has been recovered and now the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case the present petition is hereby allowed and order granting interim bail dated 14.02.2022 to the petitioner is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of accordingly, so also the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any.
