Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.16 dated 28.09.2018 registered under Section 3 RPF (U.P) Act, at Police Station RPF, Amritsar, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police, pursuant to the non-bailable warrants issued against him vide order dated 07.12.2021 (Annexure P-4)

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed that during trial, the petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail, but when he absented, the said concession was cancelled and arrest warrants were issued against him to secure his presence.

Considering the above background as well as the decision of this Court dated 04.04.2019 delivered by this Court in ***CRM-M No.15464 of 2019 (Balwant Singh @ Banta Versus State of Punjab)***, the present petition is not maintainable, therefore, the same is dismissed, however, it shall be open for the petitioner to avail the appropriate remedy in accordance with law.
