Appellant-Sonia has come up in this appeal against the judgment dated 19.12.2018, passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Gurdaspur, whereby the petition filed by the respondent-husband, seeking divorce under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, has been allowed.

In the present case, during the course of proceedings, to explore the possibility of settlement the matter was sent for meditation on 02.12.2019.

As per the report of the Mediator dated 12.02.2020, the settlement was arrived between the parties.

As per the settlement/compromise dated 30.01.2020, both the parties with the intervention of elders, had decided that they will cohabit

together in their matrimonial house and they decided to withdraw all the cases filed against each other.

It was also decided that the divorce granted to the respondent-husband be declared null and void and they decided to resolve their disputes amicably in future as well.

Today, learned counsel for the parties state that since the settlement dated 30.01.2020, both the parties are staying together.

Keeping in view the above facts and the settlement/compromise dated 30.01.2020, the present appeal is being allowed and the impugned judgment and decree dated 19.12.2018, passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Gurdaspur, is set aside.
