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**KARAMJIT SINGH, J.**

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. by the petitioner seeking regular bail in FIR No. 328 dated 31.12.2021, registered under Sections 3/13(1), 8/13(3) of The Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner was falsely implicated in the present case. He further submitted that otherwise also the investigation in the present case has been completed by the police and the petitioner is presently lodged in judicial custody. So, a prayer is made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail application is contested by State counsel. He, however, admits that investigation has been completed.

As per allegations appearing in the FIR, the petitioner was apprehended at the spot on 31.12.2021 and 60 kgs of beef, one knife, axe, weighing machine, 2 Kg weight were recovered from the spot. Admittedly, at present the petitioner is lodged in judicial custody. It will take time for completion of the trial, which is yet to commence. No useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the petitioner in custody for any longer period.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released to regular bail during trial on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
