The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty and property of the petitioner and other family members at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 8.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that his representation dated 04.12.2021 (Annexure P-3) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

At this stage, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG Punjab, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the

matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 04.12.2021 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law. In case, any threat perception perceived to the petitioner and his family members, requisite protection be provided to them.
