In the present petition, prayer of the petitioners is for directing the respondents to release their one month salary in lieu of the LTC allowance for the block period of 2020-2023

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite the fact that there is no dispute for the eligibility of the petitioners for grant of the benefit of the Leave Travel Concession (LTC) but the same is not being released to them without any valid justification, and therefore, the respondents be directed to grant the said benefit to the petitioners. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners have already approached the respondents by filing legal notice dated 17.09.2021 (Annexure P-3), which is still pending consideration with the respondents-Authority and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case a direction is given to

respondent No.1 to decide the said legal notice in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the above and without going into merits of the case or the claim being raised in the present petition or the legal notice dated 17.09.2021 (Annexure P-3), respondent No.1 is directed to dispose of the said legal notice dated 17.09.2021 by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of this order.

Disposed of in the above terms.
