The hearing of the case is being held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner does not dispute that a previous writ petition filed for the same relief was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to avail an alternative remedy vide order dated 21.12.2021. Within a period of 1½ months, a fresh writ petition has been filed claiming the same relief.

On a court question, the learned counsel has submitted that the petitioners have sent various complaints, however, the desired relief has not been granted.

Once the petitioners have withdrawn the writ petition with liberty to avail an alternative remedy, the second petition for the same relief in the absence of any significant supervening circumstances is not maintainable.

Hence, dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
