The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner Raksha Devi who at the relevant time was working on the post of Upper Division Clerk (UDC) with the respondent department while carrying on the functions of Divisional Accountant was served with a notice dated 04.10.2016 on account of remiss in filing of income tax returns. In consequence of the same, the notice for recovery of the amount so required to be deducted was served upon her and faced with the ignominy of the said notice she has come up in this writ petition after her statutory appeal (Annexure P10) was not decided.

Heard.

Be that as it may, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider and decide the statutory

appeal so filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In the meanwhile, no deduction shall be made from the pensionary benefits of the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
