Custody certificate of the petitioner filed by the counsel for the
State of Punjab in Court today is taken on record.

Prayer in this writ petition is for grant of parole for agriculture
purposes by setting aside the order dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed
by the Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran.

On the last date of hearing i.e. 05.04.2022, an additional
affidavit was sought from the respondents detailing therein the aspect with
regard to the case which was registered against the petitioner during the
period he had been released on parole earlier.

Counsel for the State informs the Court, on the basis of the
additional affidavit dated 07.04.2022 filed on behalf of Additional
Superintendent, Central Jail, Shri Goindwal Sahib, that the recovery, as far
as the case registered under the NDPS Act is concerned, would not be much

as he was granted the benefit of bail after a period of two months.

In the light of the above, we accept the prayer made in this writ petition and set aside the the order dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Tarn Taran and direct the authorities to release the petitioner on parole for the purpose of agriculture for a period of four weeks, within a period of four days.

Writ petition stands allowed.
