The petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner on the post of LDC in Canteen Store Department and may also decide the representation dated 18.05.2021 (Annexure P-9) which was replied in one line "your offer of appointment is under process".

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 18.05.2021 (Annexure P-9) served by the petitioner, within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Anita Balyan, Sr. Standing Counsel for UOI, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-UOI and has submitted that the UOI is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondent-UII is directed to take a conscious decision upon representation dated 18.05.2021 (Annexure P-9), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
