MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioners have approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.150 dated 08.09.2021 under Sections 323, 326, 506, 148 and 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur, who apprehend their arrest at the hands of Police.

On 15.02.2022, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the alleged occurrence took place between neighbours and at the instance of respondent No.2, petitioners were implicated in case FIR No.150 dated 08.09.2021 under Sections 323, 326, 506, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) and the offence punishable under Section 326 IPC was added subsequently. He has further invited the attention of the Court to the Annexure P-2 and contended that the parties have arrived at a compromise.

Notice of motion for 17.05.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioners associated themselves in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Surinderpal Singh states that indeed the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 15.02.2022 is made absolute.
