1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 11.8.2021, in CRM-M-32261-2021.

3. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 11.8.2021 reveals that CRM-M-32261-2021, was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to decide representation dated 17.7.2021 and reminder dated 30.7.2021, if not already decided, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Learned counsel contends that the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondent to do the
needful.

4. Learned DAG, has filed compliance report alongwith order Annexure R-1 dated 1.3.2022, deciding the representation of the petitioner as well as reminder thereof. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to take appropriate proceedings in accordance with law for redressal of his grievance in terms of Annexure R-1.

5. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel.

6. Admittedly, order dated 1.3.2022 Annexure R-1 has been passed in compliance of order dated 11.8.2021 in CRM-M-32261-2021. Accordingly, in the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner to take steps in terms of order Annexure R-1 dated 01.03.2022 to seek redress of his grievances by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
