It is mentioned that the petitioner would be entitled to the same relief as sought in terms of the judgment rendered in Harbans Lal vs. State of Punjab and others i.e. the daily wage service rendered by the petitioner as SPO upto the date of enlistment as constable would be recognized as qualifying service for the pension purpose only.
