The present first petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.156 dated 01.08.2021, under Section 379-B IPC (later on challan was presented under Section 379-B and 411 IPC), registered at Police Station City-2, Khanna, Police District Khanna, District Khanna.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, Lavish Bhalla, who had identified the petitioner and whose mobile phone had been recovered from the petitioner, has not been examined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, at this stage, with liberty to file fresh petition after the said Lavish Bhalla is

examined.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, as prayed for, with liberty to file a fresh petition after the said Lavish Bhalla is examined.

The trial Court is requested to examine the said Lavish Bhalla as expeditiously as possible.

It is made clear that the second petition for regular bail, if any filed by the petitioner, would be considered independently, on its merits, in accordance with law.
