1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions hence directing respondent Nos. 2 to 3 to take action as per law against co-respondents No.4 to 9.

2. The learned State Counsel, does not have any objection, to an order being made by this Court to the respondents concerned, to look into and decide through a speaking order, representation Annexure P-3.

3. Consequently, this Court directs respondents concerned, to within three weeks hereafter, hence decide Annexure P-3, through a speaking order.

4. However, if during inquiry being made into representation carried in Annexure P-3, the respondents concerned, is seized of some incriminatory evidence against the respondents concerned, thereupon, the latter shall proceed to, in accordance with law draw appropriate action against the errants concerned. Nonetheless, he may not arrest him/them without issuing seven days notice upon him/them.

5. Petition is disposed of.
