Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.126 dated 25.11.2020 registered under Section 307, 436, 427, 148, 149, 506 IPC and Sections 3(2)(3) & 3(1)(s) of SC & ST Act at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

The petitioners were granted interim bail vide order dated 15.2.2021 by Coordinate Bench of this Court.

Counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh submitted that the matter has been compromised between the parties and statements to that effect have been recorded by the Court below. He further submitted that in view of the aforesaid compromise, the petitioners are not

required by the police for any further investigation or for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 15.2.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
