While granting interim protection to the petitioners, this
Court passed the following order on 14.02.2022:-

“ Heard through video conferencing.

*Instant petition has been filed under Section
438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for
grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.4 dated
07.01.2022, registered for offences under Sections
306, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860,
at Police Station City Baghapurana, District Moga.*

Counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are the beneficiaries under the sale deeds executed by Charan Kaur (deceased), wife of the complainant. He has placed reliance upon order dated 08.02.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by this Court in CRM-M-5149-2022, whereby co-accused have been granted interim bail.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

List on 22.04.2022.

To be heard with CRM-M-5149-2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would appear as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, they shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. They shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”

Interim bail granted to the co-accused in CRM-M-5149-2022 has been made absolute by this Court vide order passed on even date.

Upon instructions from ASI Harbinder Singh, State counsel submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no longer required for custodial interrogation. As per his instructions, on completion of investigation, cancellation report has been prepared.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 14.02.2022

granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
