Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the security amount of ₹23,386/- deducted from the bills qua the works of laying pipeline executed by the petitioner in various villages of Block Kot Kapura, District Faridkot along with interest @ 12% per annum.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the amount as claimed for in the writ petition has since been released in favour of the petitioner and the present civil writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, the instant writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
