The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 227 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of directions to the learned trial Court to decide the application filed by the petitioner and respondents No.5 to 7 under Order 39 rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC (Annexure P/2) which was filed along with civil suit for permanent injunction (Annexure P/1) pending in the Court of learned Civil Judge (Jr.Divn.), Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents No.1 to 4 are illegally alienating the land without waiting for the demarcation process to be initiated and the trial Court is also proceeding with the trial without first deciding the ad interim application of the petitioner and respondents No.5 to 7.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the relevant material placed on record.

The instant revision is disposed of with directions to the trial Court concerned to decide the application under Order 39 rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC (Annexure P/2) expeditiously in accordance with the provisions of law.
