The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 for taking appropriate legal action against respondent No.5 in pursuance of representations (Annexures P-2 to P-4) moved by the petitioner, for taking illegal possession of land belonging to the petitioner and further for threatening the petitioner with dire consequences in the eventuality she does not hand over peaceful possession of the said land to respondent No.5.

It is submitted that the petitioner and her sister Sukhwant Kaur (presently residing in USA) became owners of land measuring 5 kanals situated at Village Malloke, Zira, District Ferozepur after getting succession of the said land from their parents. Respondent No. 5 has no right, title and interest in the said land, but he is hell bent to take the forcible possession of the said land. It is further submitted that the petitioner and her sister had also filed a civil suit No.CS/04/2022 for perpetual injunction before the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Zira, wherein vide order dated

possession. Despite the said order of status quo, respondent No.5 took illegal possession of the said land and started constructing a structure. Consequently, the petitioner moved various representations (Annexures P-2 to P-4) to respondents No.2 to 4, but till date, no action has been taken on the same.

Now, the prayer on behalf of the petitioner is that a direction be issued to the official respondents to decide the representations (Annexures P-2 to P-4) of the petitioner in an expeditious manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arun Kaundal, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and has no objection if an appropriate direction be issued for deciding the representations of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the instant criminal writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2–Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to decide the representations (Annexures P-2 to P-4) within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition and above said representations (Annexures P-2 to P-4) to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur for requisite compliance within the time period granted by this Court.
