Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.123 dated 31.08.2018 registered for offence under Section 304-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar, Annexure P-1.

Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the State.

Upon instructions from, ASI, Satinder Singh, State counsel submits that proceedings have been initiated under Section 82 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 against accused-Major Singh (present petitioner) and Karamjit Kaur, mother-in-law of the deceased.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner submits that she does not press the petition. She submits that the petitioner will surrender before the Trial Court within any reasonable time as granted by this Court and file a petition seeking grant of regular bail. She has requested that the bail petition be ordered to be decided in a time bound manner.

Request of counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

In case, the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court within a fortnight from today and moves a petition seeking grant of regular bail, the Trial Court shall make an endeavor and decide it within a period of one week of its filing.

Petition is disposed of.
