HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J.

Through the instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek protection to their life and liberty and pray for issuance of necessary and requisite directions to respondent Nos. 1 to 5 in this regard.

Vide order dated 12.02.2021, the Coordinate Bench, while issuing notice of motion, had directed respondent Nos. 1 to 5 to file status report.

In compliance thereof, status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, City District Gurdaspur, dated 5.4.2021 has been filed. A perusal of contents of para No.5 of the status report would make it clear that necessary directions have already been issued to the SHO, Police Station City Gurdaspur, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner. The relevant extracts of the said para, would read as under:-

“.....The deponent issued parawanas to the petitioners to join the inquiry. But the petitioners did not join the inquiry. During the inquiry, the allegations leveled by the complainant against respondent Nos. 6 to 8 regarding threatening were found to be false. However, the directions have been issued to SHO Police Station City, Gurdaspur, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.”

In view of the above, no further orders are called for in the present petition.

Dismissed.
