Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.01 dated 13.01.2021 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

On 11.02.2022 this Court had passed the following order: -

“As per the report, received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the parties failed to arrive at an amicable settlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR in question emanates from a marital discord between the parties. Further submits that the petitioner is ready to join investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency.

Adjourned to 29.07.2022.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined the investigation; has cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In the light of the afore statement made on behalf of the State, the order of this Court dated 11.02.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
