The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 3 to safeguard the rights of the petitioner and for restraining respondents No.4 to 7 from harassing and from taking forcible possession of the truck of the petitioner.

Notice of motion in the matter was issued on 15.02.2021 after noticing that the petitioner intends to make payment of all the balance instalments.

There had been no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing when a statement was specifically made by respondents No.4 & 5 that despite the petitioner having undertaken to make payment of the pending instalments, the needful

was not been done.

The petitioner remains unrepresented even today. It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present petition.
