This is an application for placing on record the additional documents as Annexures P-18 and P-19.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and the additional documents filed by the petitioner are taken on record as Annexures P-18 and P-19.

Main Case

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned final seniority list dated 30.05.2019 (Annexure P-15), with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

Learned counsel for the parties have informed to this Court that the seniority of the cadre of the petitioner has since been finalized. The petitioner does not have any grievance against the final seniority as such.

Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
