Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant him admissible family pension under the Swatantrata Sainik Samman Pension Scheme for the first generation of the successors of the Freedom Fighters, applicable 2% direct reservation and bus pass facility.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitsthat qua his grievance, petitioner caused issuance of various representations and a legal notice dated 17.08.2021 (Annexure P-6), the same have not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the instant petition.

3. Learned State counsel, on advance service, joins proceedings and submits that competent authority shall take appropriate decision on the pending legal notice dated 17.08.2021 (Annexure P-6).

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per legal notice dated 17.08.2021 (Annexure P-6) and also in view the contentions raised in the present petition by

treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law.

- 6. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible.
- 7. Disposed of accordingly.
