[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 27.07.2018, in CRM-M No.8798 of 2018 in case titled as '**Amritpal Singh**versus**State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CRM-M No.8798 of 2018, was disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to expedite the investigation and complete the same preferably within six months.

[3] Learned DAG, Haryana, refers to paragraph No.2 of the reply to contend that investigation in FIR No.276 dated 22.10.2017 registered under Sections 147/148/149/285/341/307/427 and 506 IPC and Arms Act at Police Station City Dabwali stands completed and challan / final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was prepared on 12.01.2020 and filed in the Court of the Area Magistrate, Dabwali on 16.03.2020, besides departmental proceedings have been ordered vide Annexure R-1

by initiating regular departmental inquiry against the concerned officials for delay in completing investigation. Copy of the reply is stated to have been furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

[4] However, none is present on behalf of the petitioner, nor has any request for adjournment or pass over been made. Same was the position on 16.05.2020, therefore the matter was adjourned to today and ordered to be shown in the list of urgent cases.

[5] In view of the position noted above, it is apparent that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition. Instant petition is accordingly *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
