for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.100 dated 05.10.2021 registered
under Sections 452, 323, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Joga, district
Mansa.

On 15.02.2022, this Court had passed the following order : -

Sukhdev Singh vs. State of Punjab.*

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-45550-2021.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's joining investigation as and when called by the investigating agency as also abiding by the other conditions provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C, in the event of his arrest in FIR No.100, dated 05.10.2021, registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Joga, District Mansa, he shall be released on ad interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer."

Learned State counsel submits that under the afore quoted order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation; cooperated with the investigating agency and that his custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In view of the above, the interim order of this Court dated 15.02.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
