Prayer is the for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.258 dated 18.09.2021 registered under Sections 307, 323, 34 of IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

A status report by way of affidavit of Shubeg Singh, PPS Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Fazilka filed on behalf of respondent/State, is taken on record.

As per the said status report, petitioner no.1 Sandeep Singh has been declared innocent vide DDR No.11 dated 27.08.2022.

In view of the above, the present petition qua petitioner No.1 Sandeep Singh has been rendered infructuous and disposed of accordingly.

As per the aforesaid status report, offence under Section 307 IPC has been deleted and in its place offence under Section 336 IPC is added vide DDR No. 22 dated 14.02.2022.

apprised this Court that petitioner No.2, who has joined the investigation with the police is not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation as the recovery of weapon has been effected from him

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition qua the petitioner no.2 Gurnam Singh is allowed and order dated 17.02.2022 is hereby made absolute qua said petitioner. However, petitioner No.2 should abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
