1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 17.07.2020, in CWP-10083-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-10083-2020 was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide legal notice dated 26.02.2020 by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled for any monetary benefit, to release the same within next three months.

3. At the outset, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 02.03.2022 deciding the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 26.02.2020 and also releasing payment to the petitioner as per his entitlement. Aforementioned order is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states

the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

4. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel.

5. Admittedly, order dated 02.03.2022 has been passed by the respondent in compliance of order dated 17.07.2020 in CWP-10083-2020.

6. In the light of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is called for against the respondent. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as such.
