The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 i.e. District Food & Supplies Controller, Ambala to produce the record of allotment of Fair Price Shop (Depot) in favour of respondent No.5-Sarabjit Kaur wife of Rupinder Singh and also raised a challenge to the allotment of Fair Price Shop (Depot) in favour of respondent No.5.

Written statement on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 by way of affidavit of District Food & Supplies Controller, Ambala has been filed. The relevant part of the same is reads as under:

“11. That it may be relevant to mention here that the respondent NO. 5 has submitted request dated 08.09.2022 to the answering respondent that she wants to resign from the work of ration depot due to some domestic

*problems. The copy of resignation letter is attached herewith as **Annexure R-1**.*

12. That accordingly the request of the respondent No. 5 has been accepted by the answering respondent vide letter dated 19.09.2022 and now no 2nd ration depot is working in the village Kambassi. The copy of letter dated 19.09.2022 is attached herewith as Annexure R-2. Hence, the present writ petition deserves to be dismissed as infructuous.”

Learned State counsel thus contends that since the respondent No.5 has already surrendered the allotment of the fair price shop (ration depot). There is no subsisting grievance.

The present petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Petitioner, however, shall be at liberty to seek revival of the present petition in case if any subsisting grievance.
