This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the pay scale of Rs.13500-17250/- w.e.f. 01.01.1996 as per the Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 1998 instead of pay scale of Rs.12000-16500/- in view of the judgment dated 11.03.2019 passed in CWP No.15887 of 2011 titled as Jagdish Chander Narang and others Vs. The State of Haryana and others (Annexure P-8) and refix their pay and pension along with all consequential benefits including arrears and interest thereon @ 18% per annum.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioners submits that, at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the representation of the petitioners dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-9) and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Even counsel for the respondents is not averse to the expeditious disposal of the claim of the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the representation of the petitioners dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-9) and take a conscious decision thereon by passing a speaking order; within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that if the petitioners are found entitled to any pecuniary benefits upon such a conscious decision; then the said pecuniary benefits shall also be released to the petitioners within a further period of three months; from the date of such conscious decision of the authorities.
