The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to revise the pay and pension of the petitioner after releasing the benefit of ACP increments and annual increments as per instructions and notifications issued by the Corporation from time to time along with consequential benefits including interest @ 18% p.a., with a further direction to decide legal notice dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P4).

Mr. Abhilaksh Gaind, Advocate puts in appearance and files his power of attorney on behalf of the respondents.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 23.11.2021 (Annexure P4) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
