In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that after he was granted extension in service while working as a Lecturer, his emoluments were decreased and that too without giving any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite the fact that petitioner is teaching the students with full workload and as per the instructions of the Govt. of Haryana itself, the minimum remuneration is 57,700/-, the petitioner could not have been paid the lesser salary than the fixed emoluments hence, the respondents are under obligation to grant the petitioner the benefit of salary for which, he is entitled for under the rules governing the service coupled by the instructions issued by the Govt. of Haryana. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 01.06.2020

(Annexure P-10), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 01.06.2020 (Annexure P-10) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 01.06.2020 (Annexure P-10), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
