SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

This is the second petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 124 dated 03.06.2014, registered for offences under Sections 498-A, 406, 383, 120-B and 483 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur (Annexure P-1).

When confronted with the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *G.R.Ananda Babu Vs. The State of Tamil Nadu and others 2021 SCC Online SC 176*, regarding the maintainability of second petition, counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the petition, however, he submits that petitioner will surrender before the Trial Court within a period of two weeks from today and move a petition for regular bail, which may be ordered to be heard in a time bound manner.

Request of the counsel has been considered.

Let petitioner surrender before the Trial Court within a period of two weeks from today. In case, he does so and files an application seeking grant of regular bail, the Trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide it within a period of three days from the day of its filing.

Petition is disposed of.
