1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent(s) for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-2, dated 08.07.2019, in CWP-18165-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-2, dated 08.07.2019, reveals that CWP-18165-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide the claim made in legal notice dated 27.04.2019, by passing a speaking order within three months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Today, learned AAG, Punjab, has filed speaking order dated 16.03.2021, accepting the claim of the petitioner on the basis of relief granted in similarly situated cases. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. However, none is present on behalf of the petitioner.

4. In view of the position noted above, no useful purpose would be served by adjourning the case. Accordingly, the instant petition is

disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if cause survives.
