This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 CrPC seeking directions to respondent Nos.2 to 5 to fairly conclude the investigation of the case FIR No.12 dated 20.01.2022 under Sections 392, 382, 384, 364-A, 365, 473 and 120-B of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Kharar District SAS Nagar.

On the last date of hearing i.e.15.02.2022, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that even though the petitioners are not named or involved in the commission of any cognizable offence, however, the investigating agency is harassing the petitioners by repeatedly calling them to the police station. After noticing the aforesaid averments of the learned counsel for the petitioners, a status report/instructions were called for through learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab.

Today, on resumed hearing, learned State counsel has filed a status

report by way of an affidavit of Bikramjit Singh Brar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kharar-I, District SAS Nagar. The same is taken on record. It has been averred in the status report so filed that the petitioners are not involved in any criminal case and they have never been summoned by the Police to the police station. It is stated that the house of the petitioners was raided since Avtar Singh (husband of petitioner No.1) is an accused in the afore-stated FIR.

In view of the specific stand taken by the Police in the status report so filed, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
