This is a first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR no.153 dated 12.09.2021 registered under Sections 379-B, 34 IPC (Section 411 IPC added later on) at Police Station Koom Kalan, District Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, even the complainant has not been examined yet.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition, at this stage, with liberty to file fresh after the complainant has been examined in the present case. Learned counsel for the petitioner has also prayed that the trial be expedited.

In view of the above statement made by learned counsel for the

petitioner to file fresh petition after the complainant has been examined in this case and the trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and to examine the complainant as expeditiously as possible.

It is made clear that the second petition for regular bail, if any, filed by the petitioner, shall be considered independently, on its merit, in accordance with law.
