Instant petition is at the hands of two petitioners who are stated to be residents of Phase-I, Model Town, Bathinda, Punjab.

Assertion made in the instant writ petition is with regard to large scale encroachment of public place/property by various owners of residential and commercial properties in the different phases of Urban Estate at Bathinda.

Writ of mandamus is sought for issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents to initiate appropriate action as per mandate of the Punjab Regional and Town Planning and Development Act, 1995 (Rules framed thereunder) as also the Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act, 1995.

We have heard counsel at length.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and in the light of the prayer raised, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition at the very threshold in

terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondents No.5/6 herein as regards the grievance portrayed.

In the eventuality of the petitioners submitting a comprehensive representation to respondents No.5/6, it would be obligatory for the respondents/competent authority to then examine the issue and thereafter to take necessary steps as deemed fit and warranted in accordance with law.
