The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing due to COVID-19 pandemic.

The petitioner has assailed the order dated 08.08.2018 passed by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Rohtak vide which the maintenance to the tune of Rs.5,000/- and Rs.2,000/- per month has been awarded in favor of respondents No. 1 and 2, respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was proceeded against *ex parte* during the course of proceedings in the Court below and he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Court of learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court Rohtak for setting aside the *ex parte* order in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid. However, the Court concerned will independently look into the aspect of condoning delay in filing any such application.
