This is an application for placing on record the written

Main Case

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the
Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari
for quashing the impugned notice dated 02.02.2022 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 4 has submitted that after the issuance of the notice impugned in the present petition, the inspection is still going on. Not only this, even the proceedings under Section 7-A of the Employees' Provident Funds & Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 (for short, the Act) have been initiated against the petitioners-establishment. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

On the other hand, the counsel appearing for the petitioner has also not disputed that the proceedings under Section 7-A of the Act have already been initiated against the petitioners-establishment.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered as infructuous.

The petitioners would be at liberty to avail alternate remedy against any statutory order passed by the respondents, but in accordance with law.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, is also disposed of as such.
