Present petition has been filed for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise which the parties have reached before the Mediation Centre of this Court.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Mr. Pawandeep Singh, Advocate, who is also present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 concedes the factum that the parties have compromised the matter but submits that as the terms and

conditions of the compromise are yet to be fulfilled by the respective parties, respondent No.2-complainant is not agreeable for quashing of the FIR till the terms and conditions of the compromise are executed by the respective parties.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to file a fresh one at a later stage.
