This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 38, dated 01.12.2021, registered at Police Station GRP Jind, District Ambala, for the alleged commission of an offence punishable under the provisions of Sections 379-A of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even as per the FIR, the allegation is that the complainants' wallet containing Rs. 500/- and the Aadhar card was snatched from him at the railway station with the petitioner having been in custody since 01.12.2021 and with the trial still to effectively commence.

Learned State counsel submitted that the petitioner would try and influence the witnesses.

Having considered the matter, in view of what has been contended and there stated to be no other criminal case registered against him

as per instructions of learned State counsel, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
