[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of orders, Annexure P/1 dated 26.09.2019 in CWP No.27742 of 2019 in case titled as Jorawar Singh vs. State of Haryana and another.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.27742 of 2019 was disposed by directing the respondents to decide representation dated 27.11.2017 within three months from the receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 27.11.2017 has been accepted vide orders Annexures R/1 and R/2 dated 02.07.2020 and 27.08.2020 besides financial benefits as per entitlement determined therein have been released to the petitioner on 27.08.2020, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
