The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to revise and fix his pension in regular pay scale along with special pay drawn by him before the passing of punishment order dated 29.10.2009 (Annexure P3 and P4), and to pay the arrears of revised pension to the petitioner along with interest @ 18% p.a. from the date of superannuation till actual realization, and in alternative to decide the representations dated 20.09.2021 and 12.11.2021 (Annexures P6 and P7).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the representations dated

20.09.2021 and 12.11.2021 (Annexures P6 and P7) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
